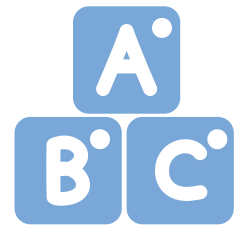

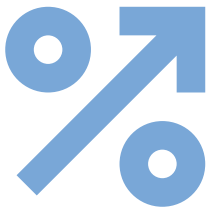

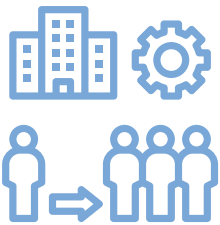

In 2022, we expanded our reach and resources to meet an increased demand for affordable, quality preventative healthcare, particularly behavioral health care in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic, and early childhood education. We look forward to more growth in 2023 as we continue our focus on building stronger families and healthier, more equitable communities in several underserved areas of metro Atlanta.
