

Dear Whitefoord Friend and Supporter:



Our dedicated staff has done an incredible job at working to strengthen our programs and services. Although we reported a deficit for this fiscal year due to a few of our major funding sources not coming through within the time period we anticipated, we are still moving full steam ahead as we make up for lost traction in fiscal year 2016. We are already working hard to stay in the black, and have already exceeded our fundraising goals. We have also made a few cost-cutting reductions to stabilize our expenses while not compromising the high quality of our programs.

Some of the highlights we are proud to report include receiving our Georgia Quality Rated designation for our Child Development Program, continuing to serve families who need us the most – those living 150% or more below federal poverty levels through our Child Development and Beyond School Hours programs and comprehensive healthcare services at our school-based health centers and Family Medical Center, and providing hot meals to children in our After-School programs due to food insecurities many of our families are dealing with.

We know that with the help of our community and generous friends like you, we will continue to fulfill our mission to partner with families and the community to ensure that all are healthy and children have what they need to succeed in school.

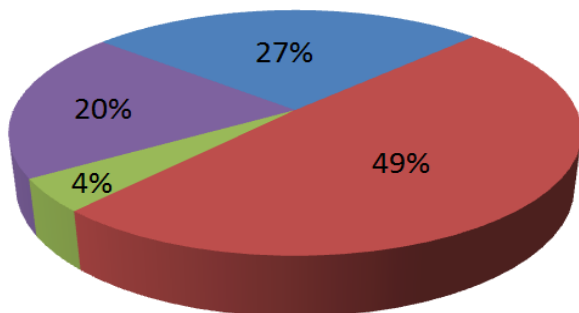

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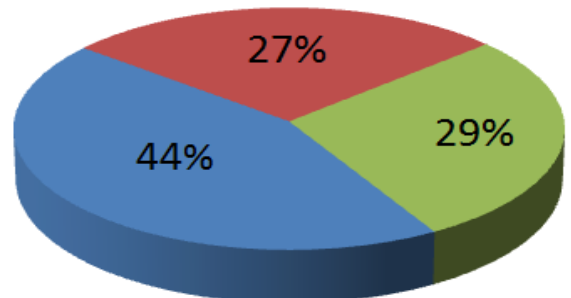
Financial Details for Fiscal Year 2014-2015

Focus on Healthcare
